By this petition the petitioner has challenged the action of the respondents in promoting Sh.Gurmail Singh w.e.f. 18.05.2007 even though he was junior to the petitioner.

The main argument of the learned counsel is that his record was not bad. That may be so, but as per the material placed on this case the record of Sh.Gurmail Singh was better and the Service Rules mandate that promotion has to be made on the basis of selection-cum-seniority.
