By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release gratuity and leave encashment along with other benefits to the petitioner.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner was appointed as Clerk in the office of respondent No.4 and he was retired from service on 30.11.2016 after attaining the age of 58 years but till today a period of more than 7 months have been elapsed, the retiral benefits have not been released to the petitioner by the respondents so far, despite having been served through legal notice dated 06.05.2017 (Annexure P-2).

3. The instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4-Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Jaitu, Faridkot to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 06.05.2017 and take an appropriate decision within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt

of certified copy of this order and in case of non-disposal of the matter within the stipulated period, it would entail disciplinary action.
