KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the amount of medical reimbursement has been deposited in the account of the petitioner on 09.12.2016. However, the claim is for interest on the delayed payment of medical reimbursement. It is stated that the bills were submitted on 05.10.2015.

On behalf of the respondent-State, it is stated that there was error in the name of the hospital, due to which the payment was made with delay.

Therefore, in these circumstances, a period of six months is considered as reasonable time to make the payment. Thus, the respondents shall pay interest @ 9% per annum on the delayed of payment of medical reimbursement from 05.04.2016 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
