Should this Court entertain a writ petition in the nature of mandamus to issue a direction for complying with the directions already issued in an earlier writ petition by this Court?

In my opinion, such type of writ petitions are not maintainable as the remedy lies somewhere else especially by way of filing a contempt petition, if directions issued by this Court are not complied with by the authorities, who are supposed to comply with the same.

Faced with these observations, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to avail his remedy, in accordance with law, as stated above.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
