By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ, order of direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the past service of the petitioner from 01.11.1984 to 30.09.2003 rendered on daily wage basis as qualifying service towards pension and other retiral benefits and accordingly release the pension and other retiral benefits thereof w.e.f. 30.06.2016 along with arrears with interest @18% per annum with all consequential benefits.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner was retired from his service on 30.06.2016 but till date, his retiral benefits have not been disbursed to him by the respondents. Even, a legal notice dated 23.05.2017 was also served upon the respondents, to disburse the retiral

benefits along with interest but they have failed to reply the said legal notice.

3. The instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4-Divisional Forest Officer, Jhajjar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 23.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) and take an appropriate decision in accordance with law within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
