By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits i.e. gratuity and leave encashment to the petitioner alongwith interest @18% per annum since the date, the retiral benefits became due and till its realization with further direction to respondents to decide the legal Notice dated 15.02.2017 (Annexure P-2).

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 15.02.2017 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 15.02.2017 (Annexure P-2) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
