Petitioners, who are 29 in number, are stated to be permanent employees under the Rural Development & Panchayats Department, State of Punjab and serving on various posts like Chowkidar, Water Carriers, Sewadar, Panchayat Officers etc.

Instant writ petition was filed raising a grievance that inspite of having discharged their duties and responsibilities they have not been released the salary over different periods of time.

During the course of hearing today, Mr. Sandeep Malhotra, B.D.P.O, Choggawan, who is present in Court today, makes a statement that salaries up to June, 2017 have already been credited in the accounts of the petitioners. The official assures that salary even for the subsequent period and for which the petitioners have worked in the department, would be released shortly.

In the light of such stand taken on behalf of the State, counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant writ petition.

Accordingly, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
