By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make payment of retiral benefits of the petitioner including leave encashment, gratuity on the basis of enhanced limit of ₹10,00,000/- alongwith 18% interest.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 01.06.2017 (Annexure P-12) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to

look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated

01.06.2017 (Annexure P-12) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and if the claim of the petitioner is found to be genuine and legal, the necessary action be taken for the disbursement of the same.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
