C.M. No.10475 of 2017 is allowed as prayed for. Copy of the scheme dated 3.11.2007 and circular dated 25.09.2014 is taken on record as Annexure A-1 and A-2.

In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for quashing orders dated 22.10.2015 and 20.01.2016 (Annexure P-3 and P-5 respectively) by which petitioner's claim for compassionate appointment has been declined.

Petitioner's mother while working in the respondent-Bank died on 27.7.2010. Petitioner as on that date was minor. He attained the age of major only on 29.04.2014. Thereafter, petitioner was required to submit application for compassionate appointment within six months as per the policy dated 3.11.2007 (Annexure A-1). Petitioner has not challenged the clause relating to time limit stipulated for making application in the policy or scheme. In the absence of the same, declining appointment to the petitioner on the score that petitioner has not submitted application for compassionate appointment within the time limit stipulated in the scheme is

in order. It was also noticed that petitioner do not fulfill the criteria

particularly para 2.1 of the scheme. Hence, no ground is made out to interfere with the impugned order.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
