Petitioner was offered appointment as temporary constable on 23.12.2016. However, his name has been removed from enrollment on the ground that the merit list has been revised on 4.1.2017.

Upon notice, learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Sarabjit Singh, Senior Assistant, office of DGP, Punjab submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the impugned order dated 04.01.2017 (**P-6**) has been withdrawn and petitioner would be issued a Show Cause Notice mentioning details for his removal from service and he will be provided full opportunity of hearing and thereafter a fresh order will be passed.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes the aforesaid fact

and submit that present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the parties, present petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
