In this petition the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ
in the nature of certiorari quashing Advertisement No.6 of 2016
(Annexure P-3).

The grievance of the petitioner is that 17 posts of SC
category have been advertised whereas as per Annexure P-4 20%
reservation is intended for incumbents belonging to SC category. We
may extract the relevant portion of the circular prescribing the
quantum of reservation, as under :-

“1. In case of direct recruitment in Class I & II Posts.

Sr. No.	Category	Quantum of reservation	Roster points
(a)	Scheduled Castes	20%	4-8-14-18-24-28-34-38-42-50-54- 58-64-68-74-78-84-88-94-100”

It is evident that the number of available vacancies have to be worked out as per the roster point. The petition, however, is silent on this aspect and repeated questions from this court to the learned counsel for the petitioner have evoked no plausible response except stubborn insistence on the point that 20% reservation is prescribed. We are thus unable to appreciate the contention in the right perspective in the absence of any relevant information that may support the cause of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there was backlog of 5 vacancies at least. We are unable to appreciate this contention as well for the reason aforestated.
