By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant annual grade increment for the years 2011 and 2012 along with step-up increment under 4/9/14 Scheme and remaining pay of suspension period, calculate and pay the revised DCRG and pension, 10% of GPF, interest on the delayed payment of his post retirement benefits @ 18% from due date till its payment.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Punjab, Patiala to decide the representation dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure P-7) within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Punjab, Patiala to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure P-7) and to decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
