Learned counsel for the State submits that he has not received any instructions despite notice having been issued on 07.07.2017, stating therein that the petitioners' daughter being 100% disabled, the petitioner is seeking to be posted to a school at Jacobpura, Gurugram, where she was earlier posted, there being a physiotherapy centre nearby.

In view of the fact that no instructions have been received by learned State counsel, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3, i.e. the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, to look into the grievance of the petitioner and to take a decision on her representation dated 24.04.2017 (Annexure P-9), within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, though the said representation is actually addressed to respondent no.2, i.e. the Additional Chief Secretary, Department of School Education. If respondent no.3 is not

would take a decision on the aforesaid representation, within the aforesaid stipulated period.

A short span of time for decision on the representation is being given, in view of the fact that obviously the children in the school need to have a teacher posted there.

However, till the decision is taken, the post shall not be filled up and if the decision is taken adverse to the petitioner, it shall still not be filled up for a further period of 5 days after the order of the competent authority is served upon the petitioner.
