This petition is filed in order to challenge the order dated 5.6.2017, purported to have been passed under Section 20 of the Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act, 1994 [for short 'the PCPNDT Act'], suspending the registration of the petitioner and also sealing the machine determining the sex of the foetus.

The impugned order, in my opinion is appealable in terms of Section 21 of the Act and hence, this petition, filed invoking the extraordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court, in the presence of ordinary statutory jurisdiction, is not maintainable. Thus, the present petition is hereby dismissed on this ground alone.
