By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retirement-cum-service benefits of the petitioner, alongwith interest for delayed period.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though petitioner has moved a representation (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.4 but till date no action has been taken on the same. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to decide the representation dated May 15, 2017 (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated May 15, 2017 (Annexure P-4) and to decide the same

within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case the claim of the petitioner is found to be genuine, to release the amount immediately.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
