By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay interest on delayed payments @ 9% per annum in lieu of payments already made by respondent No.4, in view of legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (P-1) which has been withheld by the respondents-department illegally and arbitrarily.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4- Executive Officer, Nagar Council, Sangrur to decide the legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- Executive Officer, Nagar Council, Sangrur to look into the grievances unfolded

by the petitioner in her legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-1) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the claim of the petitioner is found to be legal and genuine, the payment of the amount be released to her within a reasonable period.
