By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to refix the pension of the petitioners as per Government circular dated 17.08.2009 and 22.02.2010 (Annexures P-7 to P-9) on account of increase in pay scales/grade pay and revise pensionary benefits notionally especially in view of the judgment of this Court in ***CWP No. 27687 of 2013 titled as Kuldip Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 12.12.2016 (Annexure P-13).

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a legal notice dated 14.03.2017 (Annexure P-14) has been served upon the respondents for the necessary relief but no action is being taken and he would

be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the said legal notice within a specified period.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 14.03.2017 (Annexure P-14) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order; that too keeping in view the judgment passed by this Court in the case of *Kuldip Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others* (Annexure P-13).

However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
