The grievance of the petitioners in this writ petition is that their objections-cum-representation dated 31.05.2017 submitted against the notice under Section 13(2) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest (Second) Act, 2002, has not been decided in accordance with law as no reasoned order, which is required to be passed, has been conveyed to them.
