This petition is filed to challenge the impugned orders passed in the partition proceedings. Admittedly, mode of partition was not challenged by the petitioners on the basis of which *Naksha Be* was prepared by the Field Kanungo. If the petitioners were not satisfied in respect of the manner in which the land was distributed by the Field Kanungo, they had an opportunity and right to challenge the preparation of *Naksha Be* but no objection was raised at that time and the objection has actually been raised after the *Sanad Taqsim* was prepared.

In view thereof, I do not find any reason to interfere in this petition and hence, the same is hereby dismissed being denuded of any merit.
