Petitioner seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondent No.4 to vacate the property of the petitioner. It is contended that same is occupied by local police officials. Learned State counsel, however, refutes this plea. According to him, enquiry was got conducted and property has been found to be in possession of some other person.

As stand of the parties are at variance, same cannot be adjudicated in the writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
