By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ order or directions, especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the arrear of leave encashment, gratuity on fixation of DA @ 119% in view of Government letter No.22/8/16-DFP2/305 dated 06.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) along with interest @ 12%.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a legal notice dated 20.04.2017 (Annexure P-4) was served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken by the respondents.

3. The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated 20.04.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take an appropriate decision especially in

view of the instructions issued vide memo No.22/8/2016-3F.P.2/305 dated 06.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
