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DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (Oral)

While issuing notice of motion, the operation of impugned order dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure P-8) was stayed till the next date of hearing *i.e.* 20.07.2017 and learned State counsel was directed to get instructions in this regard.

Learned State counsel submits that the respondents have decided to reconsider the claim of the petitioners and the orders of reversion have been withdrawn. Learned counsel also submits that necessary action will be taken in accordance with law after affording

adequate opportunity of hearing and following the procedure as laid down under the Rules and law.

Since the impugned orders of reversion have been withdrawn by the respondents and the cases of the petitioners and another similarly situated persons will be considered after affording opportunity of hearing, therefore, in view of submissions made by learned counsel for respondents, the present petition has become infructuous as the impugned orders have been withdrawn.

However, it is directed that the respondents will proceed with the matter in accordance with law and after affording opportunity of hearing and following the procedure as laid down under the relevant law and rules.

It is also directed that in case it is required to hear the caveator, he be given an opportunity, if necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
