The petitioner has sought the following relief:-

“Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of an appropriate writ, direction or order in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents not to allow the diversion of natural flow of rainy water from West to East towards opposite side which is from East to West as is attempted to be done by some vested interest due to political rivalry just to harm the public at large and the petitioner and to direct the respondents to get the work done by the Government in a proper manner under some project of the Municipality to first get the levelling work of the street done and then accomplish the work of Government out of the grant given for this purpose under the supervision of the Government Technical Staff and further directing the respondents to take

proper measures for stopping the entrance of flooded rainy water of 18 feet wide street to 11 feet street to safeguard the public at large dwelling in the 11 feet wide street and for the issuance of any other writ, direction or order as this Hon'ble court may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

Learned counsel for the Municipal committee has submitted that the work of laying down underground pipe has been done, therefore, the relief sought in the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the aforementioned fact, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
