By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 30.07.2007 to the extent whereby the gratuity of the petitioner has been wrongly forfeited against the law as well as for setting aside of order dated 29.09.2010 whereby the suspension period of the petitioner after his compulsory retirement has been treated wrongly as period not spent on duty. And further for issuance of directions to respondents to release the retiral benefits to the petitioner in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though various representations including representation (Annexure P-6) were moved to respondent(s) but till date, no action has been taken.

3. The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation with regard to the relief of gratuity and take an appropriate decision in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after hearing the petitioner, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
