The petitioner, who is working as Multi Purpose Health Supervisor (Mali), challenges the transfer order dated 30.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) from CHC Kharakramji (Jind) to PHC Jakholi, CHC Rajound (Kaithal) against respondent No.2, Narender Singh, as both are swapping stations.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that it is apparent from the transfer order that it is on the request of the private-respondent, since no TA/DA and joining time has, admittedly, been given to the said employee. It is, accordingly, submitted that the transfer order is liable to be quashed on this ground.

The official-respondent has, admittedly, not been approached for the necessary grievance and transfer orders are not likely to be interfered by this Court, except on the grounds of *mala fide*, which is the settled principle. In such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that it is open to the petitioner to approach respondent No.1, for the redressal of his grievance, firstly by filing an appropriate representation, bringing out the difficulties which he is facing on account of the impugned order. Needless to say that on such a representation having been filed, the said respondent shall take into consideration the same and take a decision, expeditiously, within a period of one week, thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of, in the above-said terms.
