In the instant writ petition, petitioner has sought for the following relief:

“(i) Civil Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to conclude the verification of candidature of the petitioner for the post of Single Window operator under IBPS-CRP-IV within a time frame manner after having afforded an opportunity to him and he be appointed if, he is found eligible in verification.

(ii) It is further prayed that a writ in the nature of mandamus be issued to the respondents directing them to reserve one post for the candidature of the petitioner as he has already qualified his written test as well as interview and his candidature has been kept pending for the reason which cannot be attributed to the petitioner.”

During pendency of this petition, respondents have passed a speaking order on 23.10.2017. Since the petitioner has sought for only direction, therefore, petition do not survive for consideration in view of the order dated 23.10.2017.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed of. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to file fresh petition in challenging order dated 23.10.2017.
