JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay interest @ 12% per annum to petitioner on the delayed payment of various retiral benefits as detailed in the writ petition as also interest @ 15% per annum on the above said interest which had accrued to him way back in the year 2005.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 22.11.2016 (Annexure P-3) was moved to the respondent(s) but till date, no action has been taken.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated

22.11.2016 (Annexure P-3) and to decide the same, in view of the observations made by Full Bench of this Court in case captioned as “*AJS Randhawa vs. State of Punjab*”, 1998 (1) SCT 343, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
