The present petition has been filed seeking direction to the respondents to take steps for identification of street vendors in terms of the provisions of the Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014 (for short 'the 2014 Act').

The definite stand of the respondents is that the steps have already been taken and the agency engaged to carry out survey of all the street vendors has completed the work. Rules to be framed under the 2014 Act have been approved by the Government and these have been sent to press for publication. For settlement of any dispute, the State has notified a Dispute Redressal Committee vide notification dated 27.12.2016, which is presided over by a ret'd. Additional District Judge.

As required steps under the provisions of the 2014 Act have already been taken, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is dismissed.
