The prayer raised in the present petition is that the petitioner be considered eligible for the post of PGT Computer Science which prescribes the following eligibility conditions : -

- (i) M.Sc. Computer Science (Regular two year course)/ MCA (Regular three year course) / BE/B.Tech. Computer Science / Computer Engg. / IT (Regular Course) with 55% aggregate marks from a recognized university;
- (ii) Matric with Hindi/ Sanskrit or 10+2/B.A./M.A. with Hindi as one of the subject.
- (iii) Certificate of having qualified Haryana teachers Eligibility Test (HTET)/ School Teachers Eligibility Test (STET).
- (iv) Consistent good academic record.”

The petitioner had been ousted from consideration as she is M.Tech in computer science.

During the pendency of the writ petition, a clarification was sought from AICTE which opined in favour of the petitioner to note that M.Tech Computer Science can be equatable to the eligibility prescribed in the rules.

As has been stated by learned State counsel on instructions that the respondents have also granted consideration to the petitioner by treating her as eligible. We are thus of the opinion that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
