ARUN PALLI, J. (ORAL):

This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for a writ of mandamus directing the executing Court to decide the execution petitions preferred by the petitioners, expeditiously, and within a specified time.

Concededly, the executing Court is seized of the matter and a part of the compensation has already been released to the petitioners. In any event, the prayer made by the petitioners in this petition cannot be countenanced. If the petitioners are indeed aggrieved on account of prolongation of the execution proceedings, they ought to have moved the executing Court, itself, in the first instance.

No ground is made out to interfere in the extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
