By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the daily wage service of the petitioner from 01.10.1984 to 19.12.1996 towards qualifying service for pension and retiral benefits and accordingly release the pension and retiral benefits w.e.f. the date of retirement of the petitioner along with arrears thereof with interest @ 18% per annum. With further prayer to release the salary from 18.10.1995 to 31.01.1996 with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a legal notice dated 29.03.2017 (Annexure P-4) was duly served upon the respondent(s) but despite

the fact that a period of more than 3 months has elapsed, no action has been taken.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- Executive Engineer, Provincial Division No.4, PWD (B&R), PGIMS Campus, District Rohtak to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 29.03.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
