The petitioner is aggrieved of the impugned orders dated 02.12.2015 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.1 and 08.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2, whereby the petitioner has been suspended from the post of Sarpanch.

Mr. T.N. Sarup, Addl. A.G., Punjab submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the inquiry has culminated into final order of removal of the petitioner as Sarpanch.

In view of the above, cause of action, in the present writ petition, does not survive as the petitioner shall have an independent remedy to challenge the final order of removal.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the aforementioned final order.
