The petitioner was amongst the candidates who were granted admission in Bachelor of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry degree course by respondent No.2-Institute in a totally illegal and unlawful manner. The respondent-University declined to regularize those admissions and the writ petition filed by the students including the petitioner against such action of the University was also dismissed by a learned Single Judge on 29.05.2015, however, with liberty to the petitioner-students to “*take appropriate legal action against the authorities of the respondent-institute, both civil and criminal, in accordance with law*”, for the refund of heavy amount of fee etc.

The petitioner filed letters patent appeal against the order of learned Single Judge which was later on withdrawn in terms of the liberty already granted by the learned Single Judge.

The petitioner thereafter, served the respondent-Institute with a legal notice dated 27.09.2016 for the refund of Rs.8,59,100/- but finding no

response thereto, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any views on the allegations contained in the writ petition, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2-Institute to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in the legal notice dated 27.09.2016 (P-11) by way of a reasoned order. However, in the event of any further dispute between the parties, the petitioner shall not be entitled to invoke the writ jurisdiction as he has got an efficacious alternative remedy to approach the Civil Court.

Ordered accordingly.
