The petitioner, who belongs to the Scheduled Caste category, had applied for the post of Deputy Ranger in pursuance to an advertisement dated 24.12.2015, issued by the Subordinate Service Selection Board. As per pleadings, the selection process culminated in the issuance of a final select list on 24.11.2016 and in which the name of the petitioner figured at Sr. No.2 in order of merit in the Scheduled Caste category.

Grievance raised in the instant petition was that without assigning reason, the appointment letter has not been issued, whereas the other candidates, who had participated in the same very selection process, has been issued appointment letters.

Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that a specific order dated 28.7.2017 has been passed and conveyed to the petitioner as regards non-issuance of appointment letter to the post in question. A copy of the order has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Confronted with such a situation counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to raise a challenge

to the order dated 28.7.2017 on all grounds that may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
