By this petition the petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-19) whereby she has been ordered to be terminated.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 13.01.2015 (Annexure P-20) to the respondents and at this stage she would be satisfied if decision is taken thereon by the respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the

plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation of the petitioner by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
