On the last date of hearing, a copy of the petition was handed over to State counsel to seek his assistance. Petitioners, who are members of the Panchayat, have prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to enquire into the complaint submitted against respondent No.4.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that no complaint regarding any malpractices indulged in by respondent No.4 has been received by the authorities. Matter has also been examined and no adverse material has been found.

In view of above, this court does not find any interference in the writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.

However, petitioners shall be at liberty to pursue alternate remedy if any.
