In the instant writ petition, petitioner has sought for a direction to the respondents to provide suitable appointment with reference to qualification of the petitioner read with policy of the Railway Department in respect of providing job to one member of the family of a person whose land has been acquired in connection with the railway project.

Learned counsel for the respondents pointed out that this court has no jurisdiction since the petitioner's claim for appointment in the Railway Department jurisdiction lies to the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh. Petition is pending consideration since 2015. Therefore, Registry is directed to transmit this writ petition and related papers to Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh within a period of 4 weeks from today. Central Administrative Tribunal is hereby requested to decide the petitioner's claim within reasonable period. Respondents are also hereby directed to make necessary arrangement for appearance before the Central Administrative Tribunal.
