The petitioner's challenge to the Sports Gradation Policy of Punjab, 1997 is totally misplaced and misdirected. Once she wants to avail the benefit of reservation meant for sports-persons in the State of Punjab, there is nothing unreasonable if the policy stipulates that such sports-person must have represented the State of Punjab in Sports. The object of the policy is to promote sports and sports-persons in State of Punjab.

In addition, for the detailed reasons assigned in the order dated 11.07.2017 passed in CWP No.14727 of 2017 (Eshvita Bhadoo versus State of Punjab and others), there is no merit in this writ petition which is accordingly dismissed.
