By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to count the work charge service of the petitioner, which immediately preceded regular service, for the purpose of computation of retiral benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated 11.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) was moved to respondents No.2 and 3, but till date, no action has been taken by them.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated

11.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
