By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ especially in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to fix the pay of the petitioner at par with junior to him namely Avinash Landage, Force No.921270149.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that earlier representation was made on 01.12.2009 (Annexure P-4) followed by legal notice dated 27.01.2017 (Annexure P-5). Yesterday i.e. 13.07.2017, reply has been received to the effect that the matter is under consideration and comments of the concerned authorities have been sought. The petitioner obtained premature retirement w.e.f. 01.12.2013 but till date, revised pension and other

benefits have not been released to him.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take a conscious decision after considering all the factors mentioned in the legal notice dated 27.01.2017 (Annexure P-5) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, concerned authority comes to the conclusion that the petitioner is entitled to the relief claimed, to release/disburse the accrued benefits to him within next two months.
