Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant I call upon you to grant annual increments from year 1995 and fix all pensionary benefits accordingly and grant arrear along with interest @ 12% p.a. with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide his representation dated January 29, 2013 (P-5) within some specified period.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The Managing Director, Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam, Sector 6, Panchkula (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated January 29, 2013 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules and instructions issued by the Government of Haryana from time to time as well as judgment passed by this Court in case ***Darshna Devi vs. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam, Sector 6, Panchkula through its Managing Director***, CWP No.2872 of 2010 decided on July 28, 2011 (P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
