By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent to release final payment of retiral benefits which have been partially paid till now along with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though legal notice dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) was duly served upon the respondents, but till date, no action has been taken by the respondents.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) and to decide the same within a period of three

months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
