The petitioners who are 98 in number and are working as Master/Mistress seeks a direction to remove the anomaly in the pay of petitioners by fixing their pay at par with their juniors in terms of the judgment delivered in ***CWP No.11254 of 2010 'Neelam Rani Vs. The State of Haryana and others'*** decided on 15.05.2013 (Annexure P-9), which was followed in ***CWP No.4739 of 2011 'Mukesh Kumar Bhatnagar and others Vs. State of Haryana and others'*** decided on 11.07.2016 (Annexure P-10) and ***CWP No.5376 of 2011 'Anil and others Vs. State of Haryana and another'*** decided on 01.02.2016 (Annexure P-11).

Counsel submits that a legal notice dated 23.01.2017 (Annexure P-14) had already been served upon respondent No.2 and the same may be decided within a fixed time frame.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies of the paper-book have been supplied.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or the

entitlement of the petitioners as such, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the said legal notice dated 23.01.2017 (Annexure P-14) within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

In case the petitioners are held entitled for the said benefits, payments be made thereafter. In case the relief is to be denied to any of the petitioners, a reasoned order be passed and be communicated to the concerned persons.
