This petition is filed by the Gram Panchayat against the proposed action to be taken in terms of the order dated 28.06.2017 passed by respondent no.3.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into consideration the order dated 28.06.2017, I am of the considered opinion that the proposed action is not against the Gram Panchayat but against the Sarpanch and the Panchayat Secretary, therefore, the present writ petition at the instance of the Gram Panchayat is not maintainable and is dismissed as such. However, if the Sarpanch and the Panchayat Secretary feel aggrieved from the order dated 28.06.2017, they can approach this Court or take any remedial action, in accordance with law.
