By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ, order or direction, especially, a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to finalize the medical claim of the petitioner and disburse the same to him along with interest @ 24% per annum from the date when it became due.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various representations including legal notice dated 12.12.2016 (Annexure P-6) were moved to the respondents, but till date, no action has been taken by them.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3  
-Punjab Health Systems Corporation, State Institute of Health and Family

Welfare Complex, near Civil Hospital, Phase-VI, Mohali, SAS Nagar, Punjab through its Managing Director to consider the grouses/grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 12.12.2016 (Annexure P-6), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, concerned authority comes to the conclusion that the petitioner is entitled to the relief claimed, to release the said benefit to him within next two months.
