A short reply on behalf of respondent no. 2 has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today, which is taken on record.

Notice had been issued in this petition, on learned counsel for the petitioner submitting that the petitioner had scored a total of 56 marks, including the Physical Screening Test and Physical Measurement Test, with the last candidate selected in the Scheduled Caste category having obtained 45 marks.

The detailed assignment of marks has been produced in Court today in a sealed cover by learned State counsel, which upon opening shows that the petitioner obtained 42.5 marks out of 90, which is below the cut off marks of 45, for Scheduled Caste candidates.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has tried to explain that the petitioner had contended that he had obtained 56 marks, not realizing that the cut off of 32.5 marks (in the written examination), shown in the result sheet, Annexure

P-3, was after including the marks obtained in the Physical Standard Test. Thus, according to him, if 13 marks are added to the 42.5 marks obtained by him, he would have 55.5, or 56, marks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that it having been shown in the result sheet that the marks obtained by the last selected candidate, i.e. 32.5, (before he was called for an interview) as displayed in Annexure P-3, include the marks for the Physical Standard Test, he has no further grievance.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed.
