By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing any independent agency to conduct an independent and impartial enquiry against the act and conduct of the respondents. Further, directing the respondents to release the medical reimbursement bill under the cashless Health Insurance Scheme issued vide notification dated 20.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) by respondent No.1.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various representations including representation dated 30.05.2017 (Annexure P-9) were moved to the respondents, but till date, no action has been taken by them.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 -Punjab Health Systems Corporation, State Institute of Health and Family Welfare Complex, near Civil Hospital, Phase-VI, Mohali, SAS Nagar, Punjab through its Managing Director to consider the grouses/grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 30.05.2017 (Annexure P-9), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, concerned authority comes to the conclusion that the petitioner is entitled to the relief claimed, to release the said benefit to him within next two months.
