The petitioners herein have challenged the orders passed by the authorities under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (for short, 'the Act'). The petitioners were found to be in possession of part of *rasta sare aam*. It is not in dispute that petition filed by the petitioners under Section 11 of the Act was dismissed by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade on 15.3.2013 and the order attained finality as the petitioners did not challenge the same any further.

In view of the aforesaid facts, once the petitioners have not been able to prove title of the property in dispute, no error can be found with the order of eviction passed by the authorities below.

There is no merit in the present petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.
