By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to release the retirement-cum-service benefits of the petitioner, along with interest for delayed period, and for which a legal notice dated 17.05.2017 has also been submitted.
