The petitioner has prayed for issuance of direction to respondent No.1 to declare the result of B.A. IInd year examination.

It is submitted that the petitioner had appeared in B.A.Ist year examination with four subjects namely Hindi, English, Physical Education and Sociology and was promoted to B.A.IInd year in which again he filled the same subjects in the examination form and appeared. However, respondent No.1 has not declared his result of B.A.IInd year examination.

After notice, respondent has put in appearance and has submitted that the subject in which the petitioner should have appeared was Public Administration instead of Sociology as per Group-II.

To my mind, the contention raised by the learned counsel for respondent is totally misconceived as the petitioner had already passed the

B.A.Ist year examination by appearing in those subjects and had appeared in the B.A.IInd Year examination in the same subjects.

Therefore, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent to declare the result of B.A.IInd year examination. It is made clear that if the petitioner would appear in B.A.IIIrd year examination with the same subjects then the respondent will not raise any objection.
